

 <p>Staying Safe Around Trains</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ALWAYS CROSS AT A RAILROAD CROSSING. A crossing has a sign or gates. Just like crossing the street – STOP AND LOOK BOTH WAYS BEFORE CROSSING train tracks. Listen for a warning bell and watch for the flashing lights. If one train goes by, look both ways again before crossing. MAKE SURE ANOTHER TRAIN IS NOT COMING ON ANOTHER TRACK. Many crossings have more than one track for trains to ride on.
