The course will begin with the detection of the impaired driver and the standardized sobriety testing procedures, the course will also cover enforcement strategies. Officers will learn how to properly document observations for courtroom presentation. Topics include:

- DUI visual detection
- Legal aspects of DUI enforcement
- Standardized field sobriety testing (to include horizontal gaze nystagmus)
- Proper documentation techniques
- Two SFST sessions with dosed subjects
