 - a) Crash Reduction in both overall crashes and alcohol related crashes
 - b) public information and education efforts
 - c) increase in seatbelt use rates
 - d) Top DUI Cop – please get your nominations in to Chrystal by November 7th.
6. If you have ideas for improvements that we can implement or just have comments or concerns from years past, please let Chrystal or Kathie know. We're also seeking vendors and sponsors who we can approach for additional prizes/awards.

III. Old Business

A. FFY 2007 Statistics

1. Checkpoints – the task force conducted 57 checkpoints in FFY2007. 27,818 vehicles passed through the checkpoints, 15,424 vehicles were checked and 118 people were arrested for OVI.
2. Saturation Patrols – the task force conducted 1,846 hours of saturation patrols, made 3,750 stops and arrested 89 people for OVI.
3. Media Coverage - the task force received media coverage for 3-D Month, St. Patrick's Day, CIOT, Prom Patrols, 4th of July OVI Sweep, OTLUA/Wolf Pack Details and other OVI checkpoints.

4. Alcohol related crashes - preliminary statistics show that Cuyahoga County has had 10 alcohol related fatal crashes through August of 2007. In 2006 there were 20 alcohol related crashes.
5. Over-all crashes – preliminary statistics show that Cuyahoga County has had 34 fatal traffic crashes through August of 2007. In 2006 there were 63 fatal crashes.

IV. New Business

A. *FFY08 Grant Information* – We have received the executed grant.

1. Chrystal will have contracts and reporting CDs in the mail to you by next Tuesday. Please have your authorizing official sign both copies of the contract and send back. We will sign them and give you an original copy and we will keep an original copy.

4. Reporting has changed. See attached sheets. You will be reporting overtime saturation patrol statistics and submitting invoices monthly instead of by blitz. Checkpoint statistics and invoices must be submitted no more that two weeks after the checkpoint.
5. Incentive Funds – in order to receive incentive funds in FFY08 we must commit to – and conduct – one checkpoint per month in the first two quarters. That means even checkpoints in December, January and February. If you think your department can commit to conducting a checkpoint during one of these months please let Chrystal know.
